Computerised receipt system gets functional at all parkings

BHOPAL: The Bhopal Municipal Corporation has introduced the computerised parking receipt system at all the parking lots in the city from April 1. The parking attendants have been provided with hand-held machines to disburse the computerised receipts.

The manual receipts have been banned and the parking contractors have been warned that if they issue manual receipts their contracts would be cancelled and police case would be registered against them.

The municipal commissioner Vishesh Garhpale has directed the zonal officers and ward officers to undertake constant monitoring to ensure that the parking contractors follow the rules. He has said that if more hand held machines are required, they would be provided. The responsibility of operating and safety of the machines would be on the parking operators. The data of the hand held machines would have to be periodically downloaded in the computer of the zonal office concerned. Failure to do so would be considered financial irregularity
